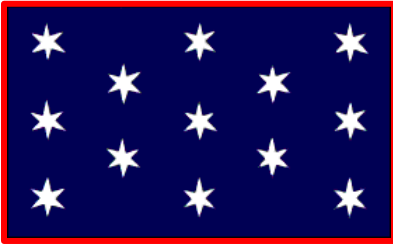

Archpriest Theodore (Ted) Boback, Jr., Chaplain (LTC) USA (Retired), is the Executive Director, Orthodox Church in America Military and VAMC Chaplaincies in 1999 first as the deputy director then the director.
