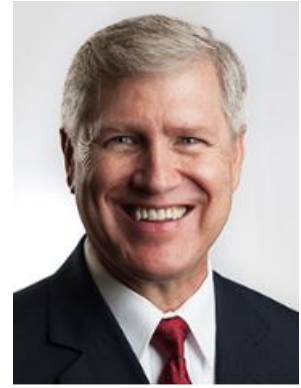

Dr. Steven E. Keith

Dr. Steven E. Keith serves as Director of the Center for Chaplaincy at Liberty University. In this capacity he orchestrates the Center's mission of educating and equipping over 750 chaplain students. Additionally, he serves as the Professor of Chaplaincy in the School of Divinity. Further, Dr. Keith is the Chaplain Endorser for Liberty Baptist Fellowship and oversees the ministry of 350 military, healthcare, prison, Secret Service, and community chaplains. Finally, he serves as a chaplain for Operation Heal Our Patriots, a ministry of Samaritans Purse for our military veterans.

Formally, Chaplain, Colonel Steve Keith (USAF Ret.) served as an Active Duty Air Force Chaplain from 1984-2014. Notably, as Director of the Armed Forces Chaplaincy Center he orchestrated inter-service education for the Army, Navy, and Air Force Chaplain Corps. Chaplain Keith served in 14 assignments worldwide and deployed several times to the Middle East, most notably to Iraq where he received the Bronze Star for exceptional ministry while under fire.

Chaplain Keith was ordained to the ministry in 1981. He holds a Bachelor of Arts, Master of Strategic Studies, Master of Divinity, and Doctor of Ministry. Chaplain Keith is married to Delta Keith and they have five children and five grandchildren.
